



Key Principles for 'Reading Together':

At Moorhill Primary School, all reading together lessons will:

- Start from one high-quality, engaging text, which is explored and developed throughout the week.
- Promote a love of reading.
- Include planned opportunities for all learners to develop fluency and reading for understanding throughout the week (prosody, choral reading, echo reading).
- Ensure that understanding and development of vocabulary is promoted throughout the week (vocab session and sentence stems).
- Teach specific reading skills through modelling, embedding practice and application each week.
- Be accurately pitched against the National Curriculum (age-appropriate texts, progression maps) and allow for opportunities to learn at greater depth.
- Model and expect high-levels of articulation from every learner.
- Enable learners to tackle the reading SATs papers in Years 2 and 6 with confidence.
- Ensure all learners make excellent progress from their starting points.
