In school, we teach children the rules of being 'Ready, Respectful, Safe' in all that they do and seeing the adults around them modelling this helps them to do the same.

For ease of reference, I have also included the information below:

Parents demonstrating inappropriate behaviour.

Definition: The term 'parent', for the purposes of this statement, is anyone who is responsible for bringing and collecting Moorhill pupils. Parents are welcome to speak with staff at the end of school day, preferably by appointment unless the matter is urgent (due to covid restrictions, communication will usually be through a phone call and not face to face). This enables teachers to give parents quality time and to hold conversations with privacy. We expect parents to be courteous and polite to everyone on the school site and, in return, all staff will endeavour to help them with matters arising. Inappropriate behaviour is when parents are discourteous, abusive or violent towards their own children, other children, staff, parents of other children or visiting professionals.



If a parent's behaviour is considered breach the school's Behaviour Policy then the school will follow the procedures set out within the policy.

We ask that parents have the same expectations when in the vicinity of the school, when walking to and from school. Adult behaviour impacts on the children – in our community, we want this to be a positive impact and therefore behaviour needs to be respectful of everyone.
